Article 'a' is used before the words that start with the consonant sound. Article 'an' is used before the words that start with the vowel sound.









'That' is used for the person or thing which is farther.





'These' is the plural of 'This' and used to refer to persons or things close to you. 'Those' is used for things or persons far from you.






