6. Wild Animals

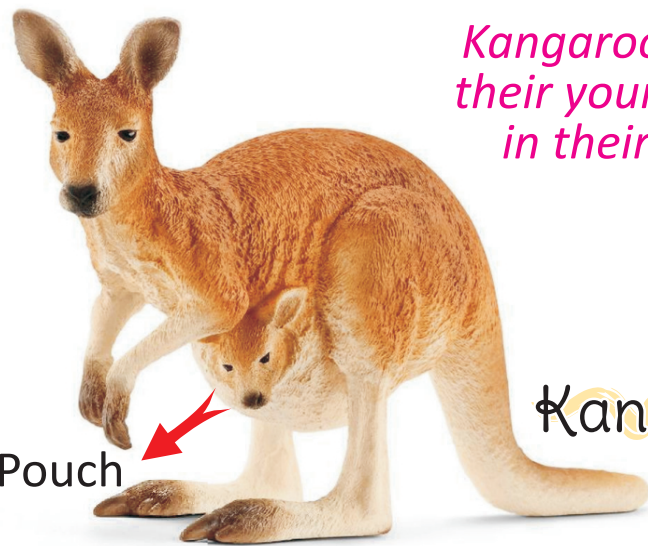
Animals found in the forest are called wild animals. Some of the wild animals harm us and some of them do not. Wild animals play an important role in Balancing the environment.
